



Quick Knit Scarf using Super Bulky Yarn

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Skill level: Beginner/Easy

The finished scarf approximately measures 6 by 60 inches (30cm by 152 cm) in size.

Supplies you will need:

One 14-inch long straight needle pair, Size 19 US or 15mm.

1 skeins of a Super Bulky yarn. I have used Loops and Threads Phat yarn here.

1 skein or half a ball of any other yarn for the fringe.

Gauge/ tension:

1.5 stitches = 1 inch, 6 stitches = 4 inches, knit in stockinette stitch

Notes:

The entire scarf is knit in one piece. The fringe is added later.

If you don't have a super bulky yarn, you can easily mix and match yarns from your stash and knit with multiple strands of yarn held together as one and achieve the required gauge. But in all honesty, this is a scarf and if it is a tad wider or longer it will still work!

How to:

Cast on 8 stitches with the Size 19 needles and the Phat yarn



Rows 1 & 2: Knit

Row 3: Knit

Row 4: Purl

Repeat rows 3 and 4 to work in Stockinette Stitch until the scarf measures 53 inches long or you almost run out of yarn.



Final two rows: Knit

Bind off loosely and tuck in stray yarn ends.

Add a generous fringe at either end in a contrasting color.
