

Crochet Pouch Pattern:

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Skill Level: Easy

The finished pouch measures approximately 5 inches by 5 inches.

Supplies you will need:

- <u>Wool-Ease Thick and Quick yarn</u>- you will need a few different colors of your choice, or you can make this entire pouch with a single color yarn. You will not need much yarn at all.
- Crochet Hook N, 10mm
- Needle and a thinner worsted yarn for sewing the ends
- Button for closure

Notes:

The pouch is made by crocheting a large square, folding in the edges and sewing to join.

Abbreviations:

sc= single crochet, ch= chain (US terms)

Color Changes:

At the beginning of the round, bring the new color in using a slip stitch into any corner. Round 1 to 4: Blue Round 5, 6: Green Round 7, 8: Yellow Round 9: Orange Round 10: Pink

How to:

Ch 4, join with a slip stitch to the first chain to make a loop. Round 1: *sc into centre loop, ch2*- 4 times, join with slip stitch to complete round. Round 2: Slip stitch to corner ch2 space of previous round, *(sc,ch2, sc) into corner, ch1* repeat, join with slip stitch

Round 3: Slip stitch to corner ch2 space of previous round, *(sc, ch2, sc) into corner, ch1, into each ch space of below round - sc, ch1 repeat*, join with slip stitch to complete round.

Repeat Round 3 till you have a square that is approximately 8 inches on all sides.

Finishing off:

Fold one corner of the square inwards to the the centre. Repeat with adjacent corners. Sew to join the seams with a whip stitch or invisible join. I used a worsted weight pink yarn that was similar in color to my last round of the square so the the stitching would not be visible.

Attach a button into place. The ch 2 space from the corner of the square will act as a buttonhole!
