

Striped Crochet Scarf Pattern

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Skill Level: Intermediate

The finished scarf measures approximately 5 inches by 75 inches.



Supplies you will need:

- Caron Simply Soft Solid Yarn- I've used 1 skein each in colors Plum Wine (Color A), Pistachio (Color B) and Soft Pink (Color C).
- Crochet Hook H, 5mm

Abbreviations:

hdc= half double crochet, ch= chain (US terms)

Notes:

- Do not cut yarn at the end of each row, carry up yarn instead.
- For neat color changes, on the last hdc- yarn over, pull up a loop. Then pull through the 3 loops using to next color yarn to complete the hdc stitch.

Pattern:

With Color A yarn, create a starting chain of 20

Row 1: COLOR A: hdc into third stitch from hook, hdc into each remaining chain (18 stitches)

Row 2: COLOR B: ch 2 (turning chain is counted as a hdc), skip first st, hdc into each remaining stitch from below row, hdc into the ch 2. Change to **COLOR C**. Turn (18 stitches)

Row 3: COLOR C: ch 2 (turning chain is counted as a hdc), skip first st, hdc into each remaining stitch from below row, hdc into the ch 2. Change to **COLOR A**. Turn (18 stitches)

Row 4: COLOR A: ch 2 (turning chain is counted as a hdc), skip first st, hdc into each remaining stitch from below row, hdc into the ch 2. Change to **COLOR B**. Turn (18 stitches)

Repeat rows 2 to 4, till scarf measures approximately 70 to 80 inches. Bind off and weave in the tail of yarn.
