



Crochet Flat Circle Pattern

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Skill Level: Easy

Use any yarn with recommended hook size. This crochet circle can be made as large as needed, just follow the increase pattern.

Abbreviations: dc= double crochet, ch= chain, sl st= slip stitch (US terms)

Pattern:

Begin with a magic loop or chain 4 and make a loop by inserting hook into first chain and making a slip stitch

Round 1: ch2 (counts as a dc), 11 dc into the center loop, join with a slip stitch to the top of the starting ch2 to complete loop [12 dcs]

Round 2: ch 2, (counts as a dc), dc into the top of the previous round ch 2, 2dcs into each stitch till the end, join with a slip stitch to the top of the starting ch2 to complete loop [24 dcs]

Round 3: ch 2, (counts as a dc), dc into the top of the previous round ch 2, dc into next stitch, *2dcs into next stitch, dc into next stitch* repeat till end, join with a slip stitch to the top of the starting ch2 to complete loop [36 dcs]

Round 4: ch 2, (counts as a dc), dc into the top of the previous round ch 2, dc into next 2 stitches, then repeat *2dcs, dc, dc* till end, join with a slip stitch to the top of the starting ch2 to complete loop [48 dcs]

Round 5: ch 2, (counts as a dc), dc into the top of the previous round ch 2, dc into next 3 stitches, then repeat *2dcs, dc, dc, dc* till end, join with a slip stitch to the top of the starting ch2 to complete loop [60 dcs]
