



# Bias Garter Scarf Pattern

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**Skill Level:** Beginner

The finished scarf measures approximately 6 inches by 90 inches.

**Supplies you will need:**

- One skein of [Lion Brand Mandala](http://www.smilingcolors.com) Tweed Stripes yarn or any 3 Light Yarn approx 500yards
- Size 7 or 4.5mm knitting needles.

**Abbreviations:**

KFB = Increase by knitting in front and back of stitch

K2tog = Knit two stitches together

**Pattern:**

Start by casting on one stitch

**Row 1:** KFB in first stitch, knit to end of row.

Repeat Row 1 till you have 40 stitches on your needles or scarf width measures 6 inches.

**Row 2:** KFB in first stitch, knit to last two stitches, K2tog.

**Row 3:** Knit

Repeat rows 2 and 3 till the scarf approximately measured 90 inches long.

**Row 4:** K2tog, knit to end of row.

Repeat row 4 till you have just one stitch left on your needle.

Bind off and weave in ends.
